



## ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION Blue Lake Centre

The Blue Lake area provides magnificent views of the Rocky Mountains. Forests of pine, spruce, and aspen surround the park's chain of five small lakes. The park provides a home to many wild flowers, trees and animals, including grizzly and black bear, wolves, cougar, moose, elk, beavers and loons.

### Cabins

Cabins available with 4 single beds in each (32 total beds). Private bathroom with shower in each cabin. Duvets with Hudson Bay Blankets, all bedding & towels supplied. Cozy fire places. Daily housekeeping not provided. Breakfast, lunch, dinner & snack provided. Lunch can be bagged. **Cost:** Cost: \$115 for single occupancy, \$193 for a double occupancy and \$77 per each additional bed. This includes meals + GST.

### Hostels

4 hostel cabins available with 6 bunk-beds (12 beds) in each cabin (48 total beds). Mattress cover and bottom sheet provided; guests provide all bedding and towels. Bathroom with toilet and sink in each hostel. Shower house is available. Daily housekeeping not provided. Breakfast, lunch, dinner & snack provided. Lunch can be bagged. **Cost:** \$72 per bed including meals + GST

### Bunkhouses

2 bunkhouses available near Cache Lake (lower site area). 15 beds available in each bunkhouse (30 total beds). Each bunkhouse is heated with a cast-iron wood stove. No running water or electricity. Outhouse, fire-pit and kitchen camp shelter available. Meals not included but available for additional fee of \$40. **Cost:** \$15 per bed not including meals + GST

### Camping

Group camping for up to 30 – 35 persons available near Cache Lake (lower site area). No services. Out-house, fire-pit and kitchen camp shelter available. Meals not included but available for additional fee of \$40. **Cost:** \$8 per person per campsite not including meals + GST (Minimum of \$100/night).

Both Blue Lake Centre and Inroads Mountain Sports Ltd. are accommodated under the same roof in William A. Switzer Provincial Park, located 25 km northwest of Hinton on Highway 40.

We are located 45 km northeast of Jasper National Park. We are 314 km (196 miles) west of Edmonton International Airport, and 512 km (320 miles) northwest of Calgary.

Direction from Edmonton: Travel west on Hwy 16 (Yellowhead) past Hinton to Hwy 40 North. Turn right (north) onto Hwy 40 North and travel 21 km. Our sign and entrance is on the right hand side of the highway.
