ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION ENTRANCE RANCH

The Entrance Guest Ranch is in the scenic foothills of the Canadian Rockies near Hinton, Alberta, just 20 minutes from Jasper National park. The cabins and suite all include full kitchen facilities so you can do your own cooking. The ranch is located 1 km off Hwy 40, 10 minutes from the town of Hinton. In true western style, horse trail rides are available at the ranch. Pets are welcome providing they can be controlled and bring your own dog beds, please. All cabins are non-smoking.

Big Bear Cabin

A beautiful, mountain-style modern log cabin with full kitchen and living room. Wood and natural gas heating, gas cooking, and running water. Two bedrooms, one has two single beds, the other a queen. A single bed in loft (ladder access), and futon in the living room (double bed). Bathroom with tub, handheld shower, and flush toilet. Rate: \$200/night, based 4 people. Capacity: 6-7 adults (\$5/person/night extra for each person after the fourth).

Little Bear Cabin

This older, rustic cabin has a true sense of the history of Entrance Ranch (operating since the 1800's) One room cabin with queen & single bed. Bathroom separate, large tub & handheld shower. Kitchen facility with two-burner gas stove, half-size fridge, toaster, coffee maker, dishes, utensils, etc. Also a library with hundreds of old books. Rate: \$85/night

Bunkhouse

Small cabin for 2-3 people. Full bathroom shared with campers and trail riders through separate door. Single bed and Futon Couch. Small cooking facilities available. An older, rustic small room cabin with a single bed and double futon. Included in the room is a hotplate, minifridge and bathroom. Rate: \$55/night

Driving directions:

Coming from the east (Edmonton), travel west on Hwy 16 just past Hinton. Look for Hwy 40 north (the big-horn scenic route to Alaska). Coming from the west (Jasper), travel Hwy 16 east towards Edmonton. About 10 minutes after you pass through the park gates the highway divides into 4 lanes. Just past this is the turn off for Hwy 40 north. Turn onto Hwy 40. Travel 6 km. You will see a road off the left for Brule. Just past this road is the Ranch. The ranch road is on the right, marked by a small log-wood sign. The cabins are half a km off the highway.

Activities:

Saddle up at the barn and head east along the Athabasca river for approx. 8 miles. Nearby is William Switzer Provincial Park for hiking and canoeing.

Rides, prices are per person

1 hr Trail Ride: Adults - \$30.00

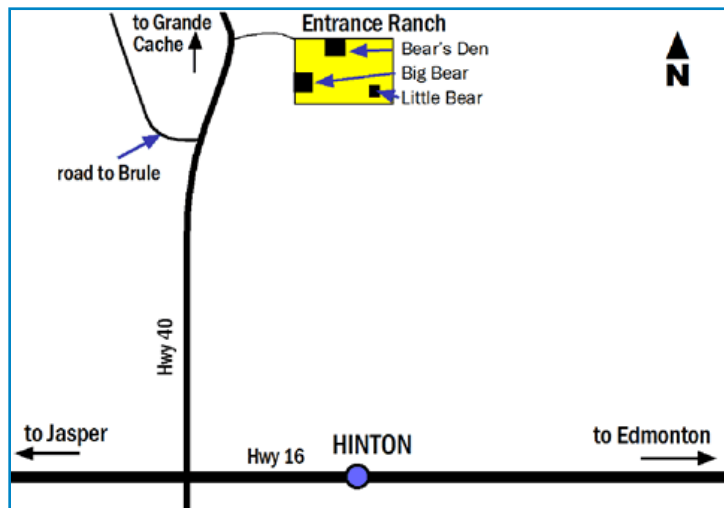
1.5 hr Trail Ride: Adults - \$40.00

2 hr Trail Ride: Adults - \$50.00

3 hr Trail Ride: Adults - \$65.00

4 hours (half day) trail ride: \$75.00

Wilderness Day Ride: \$150.00 (minimum \$400)



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
